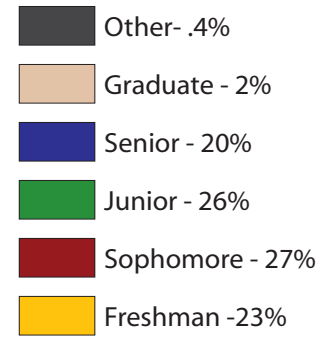
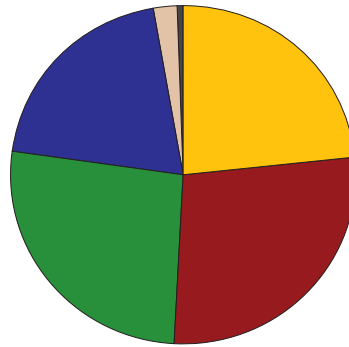
Online Voting...

In the Spring 2007 election, a total of 2991 students participated in elections; 22% of voters were African American; 11% were Hispanic; 28% were affiliated with Greek letter organizations; 52% were female; and 48% were male.
